Call to Artists

You are invited to exhibit with us at the Oldsmar Public Library this December 20th, 2021 through February 21st, 2022. We will be presenting a collection of works in The Library Commons.



Where?

The Oldsmar Public Library is located at 400 St. Petersburg Dr. E. in Oldsmar.

Patrons enjoy the beautiful architecture and airy feel, and will have the opportunity to view your art while they browse and research.



When?

We will install our works on December 20th at 11:00am*

The Library is open Mon - Fri from 9:00am to 5:00pm (reduced hours due to COVID-19)

** If you cannot make the weekday delivery due to work, contact us to drop off art at our Pinellas Street Studio.*



Framed art and canvases will be secured to fourteen deco easels, which will be strategically placed throughout the commons, as well as hung on the walls.



Miniature works & sculptures will appear in two glass cabinets. (Please bring a small stand, if you need one.)

How Many?

LIMIT THREE framed works (or canvases) per artist if you intend to exhibit **ON THE EASELS.**

If you reserve a glass cabinet, THIS LIMIT IS LIFTED.

How Much \$?

A **\$5 per artwork entry fee** covers the cost of art title cards, signage, and marketing for this and future shows.

We do not charge membership fees... TMAF exhibitions are open to all local artists of proven talent.

TMAF takes no commissions on sales.*

First come, first serve on entries.

*we will inform you in the Call to Artists if our venue expects a commission. Some do.

The Rules

Family-friendly: We cannot accept artworks that exhibit nudity at this venue.

City Venue: We cannot exhibit works that depict violence, religious imagery or are demeaning to a person's race, gender, religion or party.

No Assembly Required: Be sure that your artworks are free of damage, cleaned, and ready to go.

Bigger is Better: Artworks going on the easels should be at least 16x20 in size or they may not sit properly.

All About Sales: We humbly request that you reserve your NFS (Not for Sale) works for other shows.

Spread the Word: We expect artists to do their part by advertising the exhibition via social media, email, and word of mouth.

Acceptable Risks: We will make the best effort to ensure the safety of your art, but neither TMAF nor Oldsmar Public Library is liable for unforeseen circumstances that may result in damage.
